



Be a Child's Advocate

When making a hotline call, if you feel the child you are concerned about is not getting the appropriate assistance needed, you can attempt the following:

- When doing the hotline follow-up questions if you discover your concerns will not be investigated, you can request to speak to a supervisor. If not available, you can ask the supervisor to review your concerns and contact you.
- Contact local agencies in your county who manage suspected child abuse and neglect cases—Missouri's Children's Division, local law enforcement (request a well-child visit) or juvenile services.
- Contact your Senators and Representatives. Be prepared to discuss constructive suggestions on improving our child care systems.
